# Directions to Stony Point COVID-19 Testing Site

### Located at 9105 Stony Point Drive (next to our Stony Point 9109 building)

#### Arriving by I-64:


- From East, take Exit 181 for Parham Rd. and bear right
- From West, take Exit 181A for Parham Rd. South and merge onto Parham Rd.
- Continue on Parham Rd. for about 4 miles, which becomes VA-150 South/Chippenham Pkwy.
- Continue on Chippenham Pkwy., cross Willey Memorial Bridge and take the exit for Stony Point Pkwy. (the second exit)
- Turn right at the traffic light onto Stony Point Pkwy.
- Stony Point 9105 and 9109 will be on the left across from the Stony Point Fashion Park main entrance

#### **Arriving by I-95 North:**

- Take Exit 67B for VA-150 North/Chippenham Pkwy.
- Continue on Chippenham Pkwy. for about 13 miles
- Take the exit for Stony Point Fashion Park/Stony Point Pkwy, and bear left
- Turn right at the traffic light onto Stony Point Pkwy.
- Stony Point 9105 and 9109 will be on the left across from the Stony Point Fashion Park main entrance

#### **Arriving by I-95 South:**

- Take Exit 79 for I-195 South to VA-76 South/Powhite Pkwy.
- Continue on I-195 South for about 2 miles and bear left for the Powhite Pkwy., crossing over the James River
- Follow the "Full Service" toll signs for the VA-150 North/Chippenham Pkwy. exit, pay toll (70¢) and take the first right exit for Chippenham Parkway North
- Continue on Chippenham Pkwy. for about 3.5 miles
- Take the Stony Point Fashion Park/Stony Point Pkwy. exit and bear left
- Turn right at the traffic light onto Stony Point Pkwy.
- Stony Point 9105 and 9109 will be on the left across from the Stony Point Fashion Park main entrance
